Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) 2017

In 2017 all year levels will participate in the BYOD program. As many parents and care givers will consider purchasing their students laptop at the end of the year, please consider that the laptop must comply with the correct specifications in order to connect to the school network.

Device Selection

Before acquiring a device to use at school, the parent or caregiver and student should be aware of the school's specification of appropriate device type, operating system requirements and software. A full explanation specifications can be found in the 2017 BYOD Program Information (PDF, 802 KB) located on the school website. With the minimum device specifications we also include advice on warranty, insurance and accidental damage cover options for your device.

Technical Support

The school will continue to run an IT help desk that will offer level one support for the student owned devices, however, warranty, security, insurance and maintenance will be something the parent will need to discuss with the vendor when the device is purchased.

Software Offers

The school offers the following software free of charge:

- Microsoft Office
- Adobe Creative Suite
- AutoCAD Education

All software offers instructions are available on the school website. The installation of an anti-virus software is a compulsory requirement of connecting the BYOD to the school network. Recommended anti-virus solutions include: Norton/Symantec (DETE offers a 3 year x \$9.99 offer) or Microsoft Defender. If an anti-virus solution is not detected the 'on-boarding' process will cease the connection to the school network.

Vendor Portals

The school has been in negotiation with vendors to support parents in purchasing their BYO device. Refer to the school website for links to vendor portals. Please note these are only recommendations and it is not required that parents purchase devices through these vendors.
