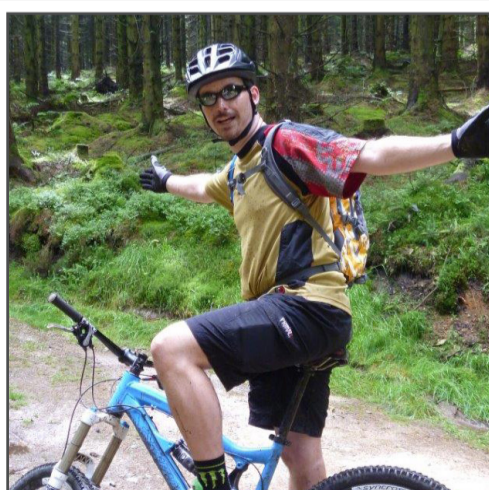


Architecture
