Erin Young *Primary Teaching*

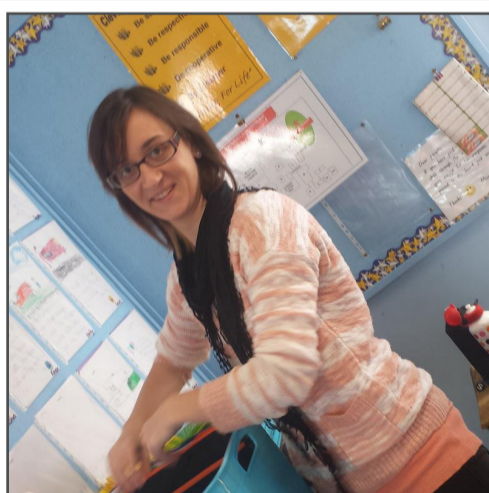
